The Department of Kansei, Behavioral, and Brain Sciences is focused on cross-disciplinary education and research on higher brain function in humans, referred to as *kansei*. By establishing such an educational system, the university aims to train students who will comprehensively understand various human behaviors related to *kansei* on an individual level.

While studying Kansei Science, students will study related disciplines, such as cognitive science, brain science, robotics and instrumentation engineering, design, psychology, ergonomics and interaction.
